

2026 Call for Applications Intealth Board of Trustees

Help Shape the Future of Global Medical Education and Health Care

Intealth[®] is seeking applications for three positions on its Board of Trustees, with terms beginning in January 2027. We are actively recruiting a **Public Member Trustee**, an accomplished leader whose expertise has been built outside of medicine and medical education, but who has a general understanding of health care. We are also recruiting **one General Trustee** and **one Resident Trustee**. The Resident Trustee seat is open to an international medical graduate (IMG) currently training in U.S. graduate medical education. Both U.S. citizen and non-U.S. citizen IMGs are eligible.

For the Public Member and General Trustee candidates, we are especially interested in individuals who bring experience in finance and investment oversight, business strategy, information technology, or cybersecurity and risk management. We invite mission-driven leaders to join a distinguished Board whose work shapes medical education, physician workforce development, competency assessment, and health care delivery around the world.

The deadline to apply is July 31, 2026.

As a nonprofit organization headquartered in Philadelphia, Intealth serves physicians, educators, health care regulators, researchers, and patients across the globe.

Intealth is recognized internationally for its expertise in international medical education systems and training programs, physician credential verification, physician assessment, and physician migration. Through ECFMG Certification and other programs, Intealth plays a critical role in ensuring that IMGs are prepared to enter U.S. graduate medical education and pursue licensure. Through its FAIMER division and programs, Intealth contributes to the professional development of health professions educators worldwide.

The decisions made by the Intealth Board of Trustees can have a direct impact on the future of medical education, physician workforce development, and health care delivery around the world.

Board Service

Intealth seeks accomplished leaders from a broad range of professional backgrounds, including academic medicine, hospital administration, business, finance, technology, policy, community health, patient advocacy, and public service.

Trustees serve as strategic stewards of the organization, providing governance, oversight, and guidance as Intealth pursues its mission and long-term vision.

Trustees are volunteers. Trustees in general Board seats initially serve a four-year term and may be re-elected to one additional four-year term. Resident Trustees serve a two-year term; Resident Trustees are not eligible for reappointment.

Serving on the Intealth Board offers a unique opportunity to collaborate with accomplished leaders and contribute your expertise to issues of global importance in the health care workforce and health professions education.

Positions Available

The Board is recruiting for three trustee positions whose terms begin in January 2027: **two general Board seats and one Resident Trustee seat reserved for an IMG currently in training.**

All candidates should demonstrate a commitment to Intealth's mission and values, strategic thinking and sound judgment, the ability to contribute meaningfully to organizational oversight and decision-making, and the highest standards of professional integrity and ethics.

General Trustees, Including Public Member

One of the general Board seats will be filled by a public member, an individual with an understanding of health care whose expertise has been gained outside of medicine and medical education and who can bring an independent perspective to Board deliberations. The second seat is a general Board position open to candidates from both health care and non-health care backgrounds.

As Intealth continues to advance its strategic priorities and technology transformation initiatives, the Governance Committee is particularly interested in candidates who bring expertise in one or more of the following areas:

- Finance and investment oversight
- Business strategy and organizational growth
- Information technology and digital transformation
- Strategic planning and enterprise governance
- Cybersecurity, data governance, and risk management
- Other experience that aligns with Intealth's long-term strategic priorities

Resident Trustee

The Board is also recruiting one IMG to serve as Resident Trustee. Applicants must have at least two years of graduate medical education remaining at the time their term begins, and should demonstrate leadership potential, an interest in governance, and a commitment to advancing excellence in medical education and health care.

Intealth is committed to maintaining a Board that reflects the diverse communities and constituencies it serves, and we strongly encourage applications from individuals whose perspectives, experiences, and expertise will enrich Board deliberations and strengthen organizational leadership.

How to Apply

Individuals interested in serving on the Intealth Board of Trustees must complete the online [Trustee Application Form](#) or [Resident Trustee Application Form](#), whichever applies, and upload:

- A current curriculum vitae (CV) or résumé
- A letter of recommendation; for Resident Trustee applicants, this letter must come from your program director and follow the guidelines provided in the application

- A recent headshot

All application materials must be received by July 31, 2026.

Selection Process

The Intealth Governance Committee will review all completed applications and develop its recommendations at its meeting on August 17, 2026. The Board of Trustees will consider and vote on recommended candidates at its meeting on September 16, 2026.

Selected trustees will participate in a virtual orientation in late 2026. The first in-person meeting with new trustees will be held January 25–27, 2027.

Trustee Responsibilities

Members of the Board of Trustees are expected to:

- Fulfill fiduciary responsibilities on behalf of Intealth
- Review and comply with Intealth's bylaws and Board policies
- Disclose actual, potential, or perceived conflicts of interest
- Maintain the confidentiality of Board discussions and organizational matters
- Prepare for and actively participate in Board and committee meetings
- Contribute their expertise, insight, and judgment to advance the organization's mission and strategic priorities

Trustees typically participate in three in-person Board meetings annually, along with virtual committee meetings and occasional special assignments.
